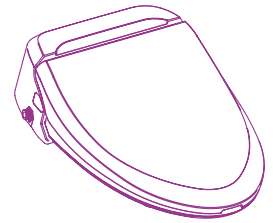

2. Use this appliance only for its intended purpose as described in this manual. Do not use attachments not recommended by the manufacturer.
3. Never operate this appliance if it has a damaged cord or plug, if it is not working properly, if it has been dropped, damaged or dropped into water.
4. Install this appliance properly according to this manual.
5. Only authorized people can install or repair this appliance. Do not attempt to repair this appliance by yourself, doing so could void the warranty.
6. Keep the cord away from heated surfaces.
7. Never drop or insert any object into any opening or hose.
8. Do not use outdoors. Do not use aerosol or oxygen spray products on the unit.
9. Always follow the grounding instruction in this manual before plugging in.

2 Cautions before installation

NOTE THE FOLLOWING IMPORTANT POINTS

1. Do not install in location where water might be splashed on this appliance or in location exposed to such an excessive moisture that condensation forms on the product surface.
2. To avoid damage to electronic components due to high levels of humidity, provide adequate ventilation by opening a window and/or door when bathing. You may find operating an exhaust ventilating fan during these times of high humidity beneficial.
3. The new hose-set supplied with the appliance should be used and the old hose-set should not be reused.
4. Use a water supply having a water pressure 0.08 MPa ~ 0.74 MPa.
5. Connect the product to a pipe carrying potable water. Do not connect to an industrial water line or other water supply that does not carry water of drinking quality.
6. In areas where water freezes during winter make arrangements to keep the pipes warm. The water remaining in the unit may sometimes freeze during storage in winter. In that case, warm the unit in the room before installation.
7. The thermal protector in the water tank may sometimes trip during storage or transportation in warm weather causing non-operation. In that case, cool the unit in the room before installation.
8. The rated power voltage is 220-240 V~ / 50/60 Hz
9. Do not supply electrical power to the unit until the plumbing installation work has been completed; it could cause malfunction.
10. Unplug the appliance during maintenance and cleaning.

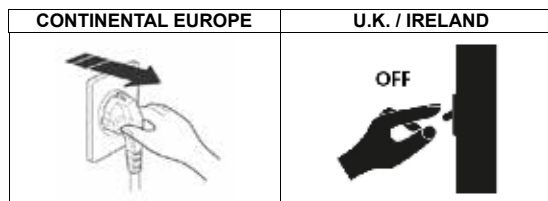

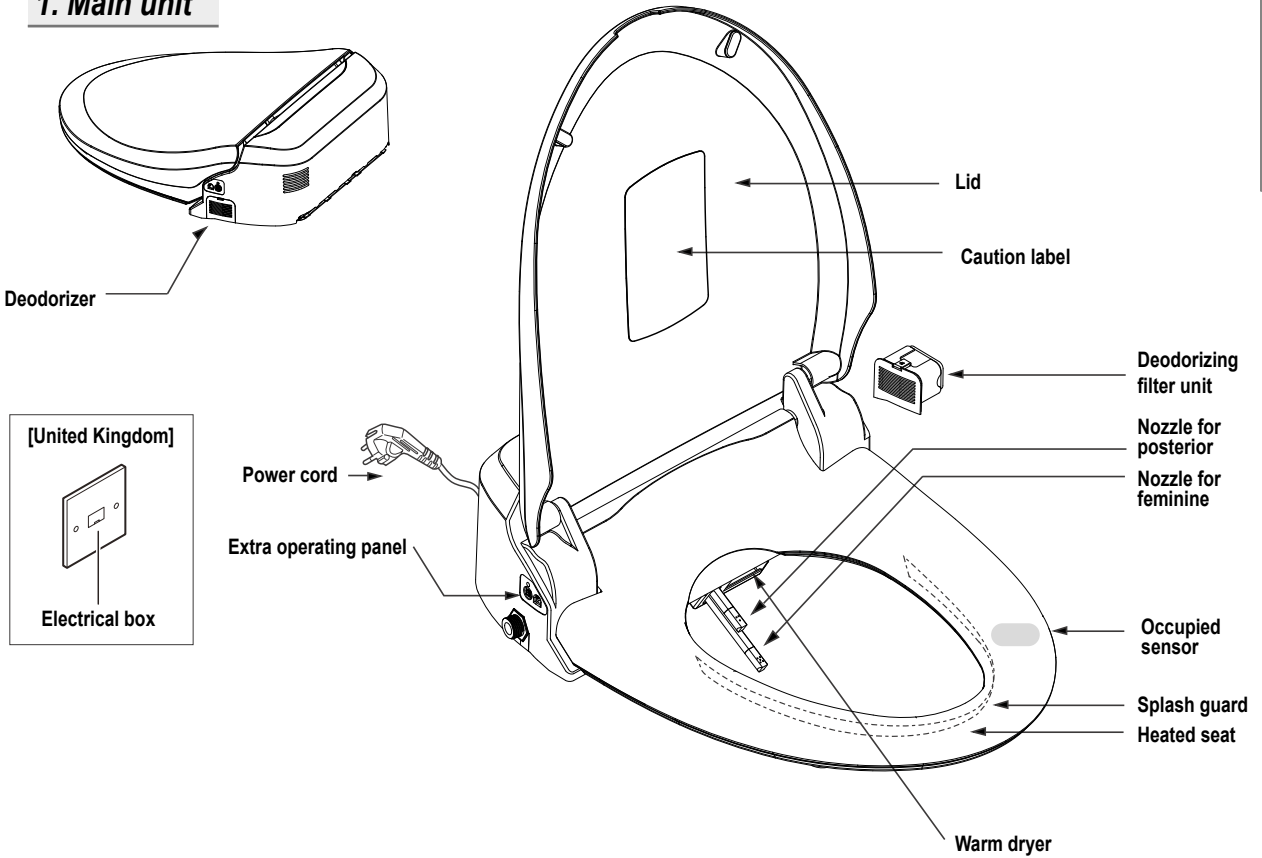

In such countries, every time the operating instruction manual refers to unplug the power cord, the user must instead switch off the circuit.









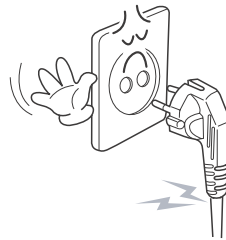
Meanings of symbols



PROHIBITED

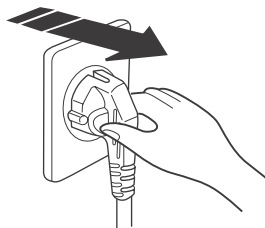
- It may result in a low-grade burn if sitting on the heated seat for a long time.
- Be aware if being used by the following:
 - Children, senior citizens, patients, or who cannot control the grade of temperature.
 - Sleeping pills users, or people who are on medication that causes drowsiness.
 - Who are drunk or very tired and may fall asleep while sitting on the unit.
- If injured in a low-grade burn, see a doctor immediately.



REQUIRED

Unplug when cleaning.

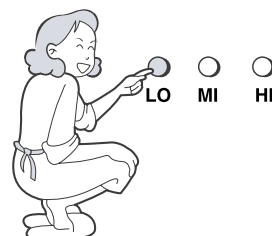
- Not doing so may result in fire or electric shock.



REQUIRED

Use the low temperature for children and disabled.

- If high temperature is set up, it may result in burn due to not recognizing the temperature.



6 How to use



Dry

- Press this button to activate warm drying for 3 minutes.
- To alter the intensity of the dryer, press the button again.
- Drying temperature can be adjusted by pressing LOW or HIGH (5 levels).



Bidet

- Press this button to activate feminine wash. The function will stop automatically after 1 minute.
- Press this button again to activate oscillation. The nozzle moves automatically back and forth to widen cleansing area.
- To stop oscillation press again this button.



Cleansing

- Press this button to activate posterior hygiene. The function will stop automatically after 1 minute.
- Press this button again to activate oscillation. The nozzle moves automatically back and forth to widen cleansing area.
- To stop oscillation press again this button.



User setting

- ※ See page 10



Stop

- Press this button to stop current operation.
- When the user stands up, all operation will automatically stop.



Eco

- Press this button for 2 seconds to activate the power saving mode.
- Seat and water temperature will be set at the lowest temperature for saving power.



Temperature adjustment (water / seat)

- Temperature of seat and water can be adjusted by pressing

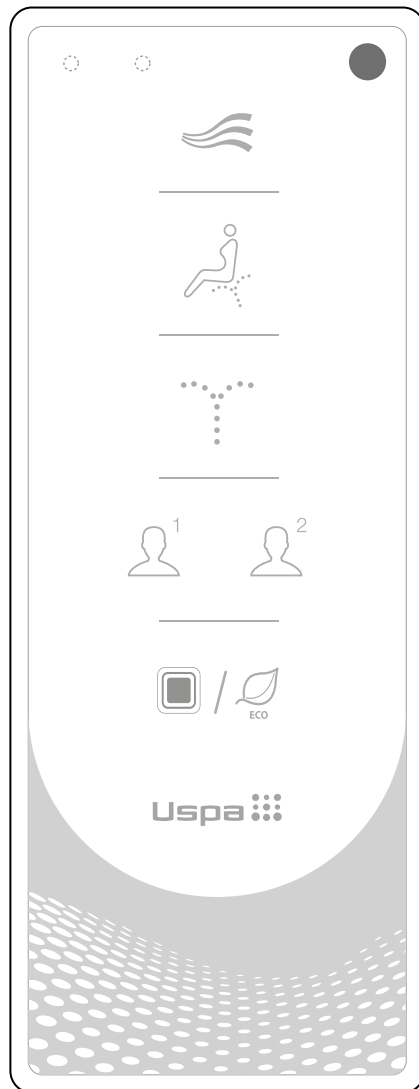


- There are four levels of temperature: Room temp (off) – Low (34 °C) – Medium (37 °C) – High (40 °C).



Battery Alarm

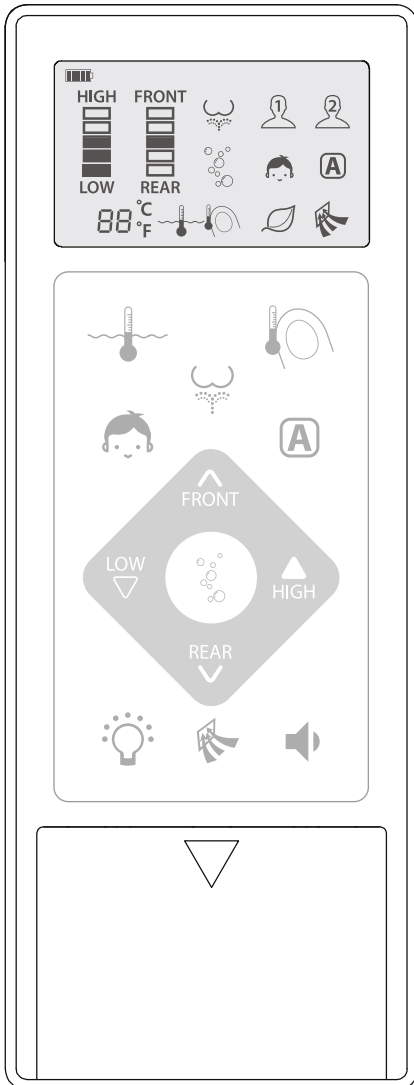
- Change the batteries if the battery icon on LCD is flickering (front LED will also flicker).



[Front]

※ Caution

- Be aware of not dropping the remote control in water. It could be damaged.
- All functions, except “Nozzle cleaning” and “Eco”, can be activated only when the user is seated on the appliance.
- Before operating, ensure that the water tank is filled up completely.



[Rear]



Pulsation (massage)

- Press this button when using “Cleansing” and “Bidet” to activate rhythmical wash with massage effect.
- Press this button again to deactivate this function.



Kids

- Press this button to change all functions to be suitable for children. It will automatically operate 1 minute of cleansing with the oscillating nozzle and 3 minutes of drying. Water pressure (level 1); nozzle position (level 5).
- Kids must use this appliance only under the supervision of an adult.



Auto

- Press this button to activate automatic function (4 minutes long): Cleansing – Oscillation – Pulsation will operate consecutively (1 minute), followed by Drying function (3 minutes).
- Press “Bidet” and “Auto” in sequence if the Auto function is desired in conjunction with the Bidet function.



Nozzle position

- Nozzle position can be adjust (5 levels) by pressing FRONT and REAR.
- After each use, position will be taken to the initial value (level 3).



Water pressure / Air temperature

- Water pressure (5 levels) can be adjusted by pressing LOW and HIGH.
- Air temperature (5 levels) can be adjusted by pressing LOW and HIGH.
- After each use, both levels will be taken to the initial value (level 3).



Aerated Spray

- Press this button to activate aerated spray during “Cleansing”, “Bidet” and “Kids” functions. This functions increase water spray intensity while consuming less water.
- Press again this button to deactivate the function.



Courtesy light

- Press this button to activate/deactivate courtesy light.
- A delicate light will guide the user to identify the device during the night, without having to turn on the bathroom light.



Deodorization

- Press this button during the use of the device. Deodorizer will work automatically for a maximum time of 20 minutes.
- When the user stands up, the function stops after 1 minute.



Sound

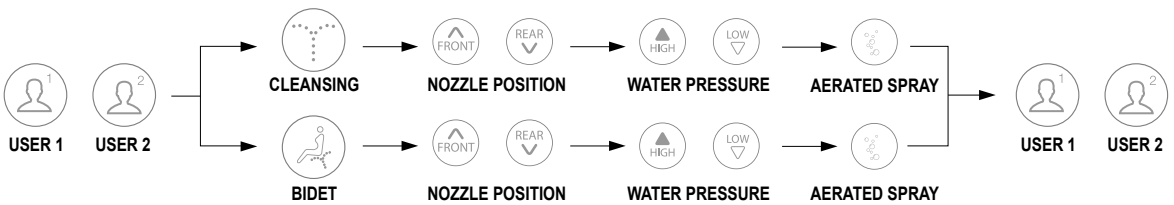
- Press this button to enable/disable the beeping sound of the device.

User setting



- Each button can save 2 settings (Cleansing and Bidet).
- Press User 1 and "Cleansing" or "Bidet" consecutively. Then choose nozzle position by pressing FRONT/REAR buttons and water pressure level by pressing LOW/HIGH buttons.
- Press User 1 again to save, with a beep that will confirm the chosen setting.

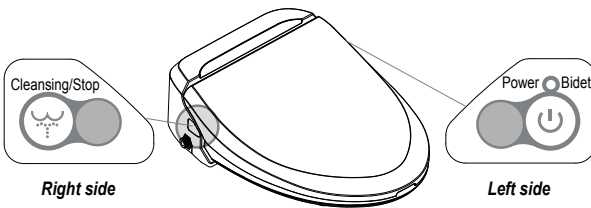
(※ The same applies for saving User 2 settings).



- To recall previously memorized settings, press User 1 or User 2 during "Cleansing" or "Bidet" functions.

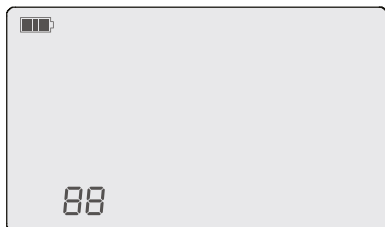
Side control buttons

- It is possible to use the device through side control buttons when the remote control is broken or its batteries are dead.
- Press "Cleansing" on right side or "Bidet" on left side to activate the corresponding functions.
- Press again the button to stop the functions.
- Do not press the buttons with sharp-edged objects.



Identification

- This function is useful for public toilets, when more than one unit of this product is installed.
- To prevent interference among units, main unit and remote control should be set with the same ID.
- If there is only one USPA device with remote control in the bathroom, there is no need to set an ID.
- Initial ID of remote control and main unit is "0". There are 16 ID codes available (00~15).



How to set ID

[REMOTE CONTROL]

- Press "High" (▲_{HIGH}) for 3 seconds and the ID will show up in the display.
- Press "High" (▲_{HIGH}) or "Low" (▼_{LOW}) until your ID appears in the display.
- Press "Stop" to save the ID.

Set the unit

- After assigning the ID to the remote control, unplug the unit and the plug it back in.
- Press the "Power|Bidet" button on the left side (see picture aside) to turn off the unit.
- Press the "Power|Bidet" button again without releasing (the unit should turn back on at this point).
- While holding the "Power|Bidet" button down, push "Stop" on the remote control for 2 seconds.

Note

- If the IDs of the remote control and the main unit are different, the remote can't work properly. Make sure that remote control and main unit are set with the same ID.
- The ID will be memorized even when the device is unplugged or when the batteries of the remote control are replaced.

7 How to clean

Nozzle cleaning

Caution Do not forcefully push or pull the nozzle. It may result in a damage to the device.

Manual cleaning

- 1 Make sure that the occupied sensor is not activated (do not sit on the seat or place hands on the seat sensor).
- 2 Press the (FRONT) button for 2 seconds to extract the bidet nozzle. Press the button again to extract the cleansing nozzle.
- 3 Use a toothbrush or soft cloth to clean the nozzle.
- 4 Press "Stop" button to retract the nozzle.



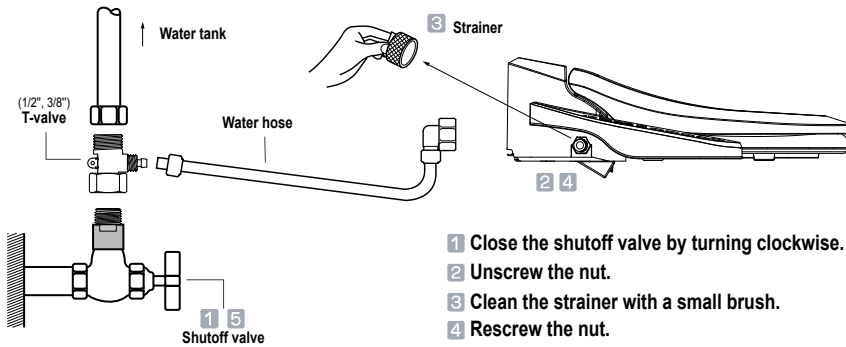
Auto cleaning

- 1 Press the (REAR) button for 2 seconds to start auto cleaning of the nozzle.
- 2 Press "Stop" button while cleaning to retract the nozzles.

※ Do not use force to push or pull the nozzles while cleaning.

Strainer maintenance

This appliance will not operate properly if the strainer is clogged. Be sure to clean the strainer regularly.

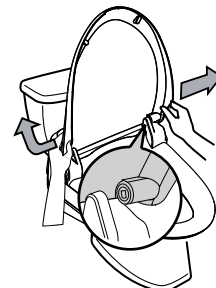


- 1 Close the shutoff valve by turning clockwise.
- 2 Unscrew the nut.
- 3 Clean the strainer with a small brush.
- 4 Rescrew the nut.
- 5 Open the shutoff valve by turning counter clockwise.

Cleaning the body

Regularly wipe off the seat with a dry soft cloth or sponge, or wash with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Release the lid.

- 1 Pull left and up the left hinge part.
- 2 Release the right hinge part (be aware of your fingers not to be caught). In order to protect the plastic parts, please only use neutral cleansers. (Do not use toilet cleansers, home cleansers, bleach, benzene, paint thinner, cresol (lysol), etc.).

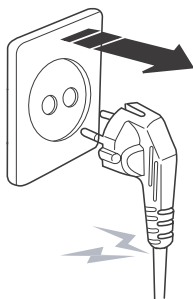


8 Maintenance

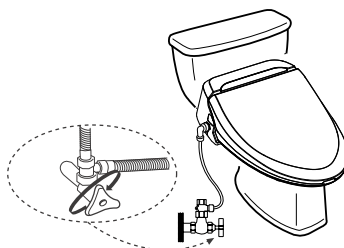
Draining water - while not using over extended period of time

1 Unplug the power supply cord.

- Not doing so may cause fire.



2 Close the shutoff valve.

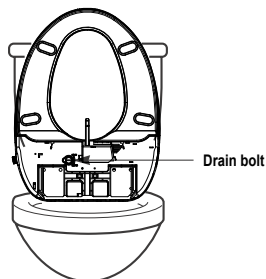


3 Detach the unit.

- Refer to the installation method.



4 Uphold the appliance and thoroughly drain the water by unscrewing the drain bolt (beware of losing the drain bolt).

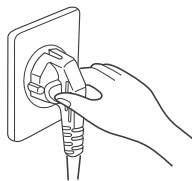


5 Screw the drain bolt and install the appliance.

- Refer to the trial operation method in order to use this appliance again.

Preventing freezing

1 Make sure the power cord is plugged in properly.



2 Set the temperature of water to low or middle. (Freezing can be prevented by thermal efficiency of water tank).

- If there is no heating system in the toilet, wrap pipes with cloth or other materials.

3 Not using the unit for a long time in winter unplug and drain the water from the water tank and pipes thoroughly.

- Refer to the water drain method.

9 How to install



Do not plug in until installation is finished completely.
Not doing so may damage the appliance.

Caution

If electric work is needed, contact a qualified electrician or serviceman only.

Remove the existing toilet lid and seat

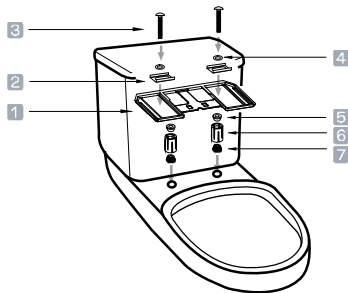
1. Remove the nuts, washers and cone packings from the toilet seat mounting bolts in the back of the toilet
2. Remove the toilet seat, lid and mounting bolts.
3. Keep them in case of installing again.

Installation

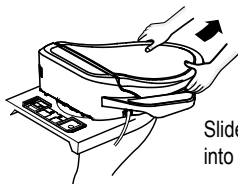
How to mount the plate

Place the plate and guides over each mounting hole. Insert the mounting bolts respecting the sequence shown in the picture.



- 1 Mounting plate 2 Bolt guide 3 Mounting bolt
4 Washer 5 Upper cone 6 Mounting nut 7 Lower cone

How to attach and detach the unit



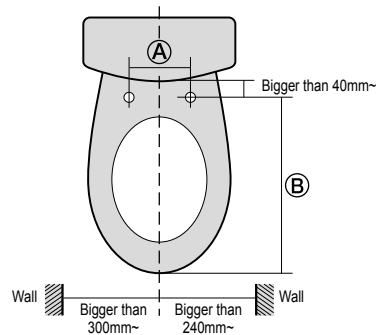
Slide the unit until it clicks into plate.



Lift the unit up and forward.

Toilet size

- The toilet dimensions must be within those shown below. Do not install this appliance on a toilet that does not meet those dimensional requirements.

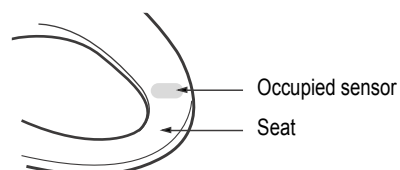

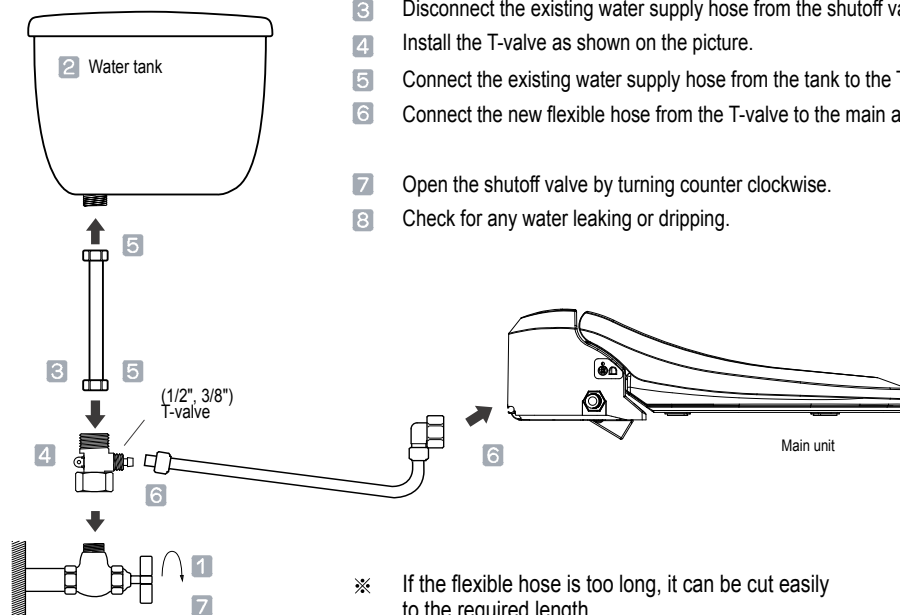

Occupied sensor

- This appliance is equipped with occupied sensor. Unit will not work unless seat is occupied.



Connecting the water hose and grounding wire



Trial operation

1. Preparation

Plug the power cord into the outlet. Press "BIDET" or "CLEANSING", then water tank will be filled within 2 minutes. After the water tank has filled up, you will hear a long buzzer sound.

2. Checking all functions

Cover the toilet bowl using the plastic wrapping sheet of the unit to prevent water from being sprayed out of the toilet. Then check for all the functions described in this manual.

3. During trial operation there are possibilities of remaining water coming out from the unit while heating.

10 Before calling for service
